Guide to Writing Reaction Paper The first part of your paper should contain information on the author and the topic. You need to write down the main ideas and highlight the main points of the paper. You can use direct quotations if needed.

The same holds true when you're writing a reaction paper to an article. Typically, a reaction paper is a five-paragraph structure which includes the introduction, body and conclusion. You're expected to devote one paragraph to the introduction and conclusion each and at least three paragraphs to the body.

How to Write a Reaction Paper on an Article?

If you find and study several examples of reaction papers, you will see that their introductory parts are organized according to the following scheme: Context (you should start your paper with orienting the readers who are less familiar with your topic and add several words about the importance of your work);

You should not only explain your reaction but also back it with quotes from the sources. Analyze them and avoid being too subjective. Of course, you have your own reasons and a personal opinion but it is necessary to back everything with proofs and links. In addition, you can write several paragraphs with other reactions.

The first thing that you must do is summarize the text by writing the reaction paper outline format (or you can call it a sample). Developing your outline for the reaction paper will help keep you focused and your thoughts in order.

How to write a Reaction Paper? What is Expected ...

Writing a reaction paper is mainly based on how you feel or think about something. After reading through the paper, you should annotate the text so that you do not miss any essential information. Explain the personal opinion about the piece and illustrate using evidence from credible sources.

How to Write a Reaction Paper - A Research Guide for Students

A reaction/response paper has an introduction, a body, and a conclusion. The introduction should contain all the basic information in one or two paragraphs. Your introduction should include a concise, one sentence, focused thesis. This is the focused statement of your reaction/response.

LEO Writing a Reaction or Response Essay

Make an outline for your reaction paper, which will be separate from the outline you used to arrange your article response notes. A good outline will lay the groundwork for an introduction, at least three supporting sections in the body of the paper and a conclusion. Another strategy is to mirror the structure of the article you are evaluating.

Book details - once writing a reaction paper, you need first to explain every detail of the analyzed book, article or movie. Thus, you need to write down the name of the author and the summary of the analyzed book. In the case of a movie, you also need to provide the name of the movie and the list of main characters.

How to write a reaction paper The introduction of your paper serves to lay out your ideas and to pique the interest of your readers. A great place to start is to name the author and the work that you are reacting to, elucidating the main focus of what you are going to discuss.

Remember that you do not need to write a long dissertation, a successful reaction paper is quite a short piece of writing. You are expected to focus on several points which you support or not. Try to make your reaction paper strictly-structured and divide your thoughts into paragraphs: one paragraph for one idea and analyze it briefly.

On it, don't skip the author and the title of the book or work you have to summarize and then write your thesis statement at the end of the first paragraph. In your second paragraph, write your first reaction, but concisely. Use a short sentence, and then follow it with some reasons to back up your reaction.

Writing reaction or response papers about documentaries require students to properly understand the given material and present and argument showing how it fits into the course work.

A basic reaction paper is an essay that is 300-500 words long and contains a thorough review of the examined topic and describes your reaction to this topic (it can be an object, literature piece, movie, article, book, etc.).

Best Tips on Writing a Reaction Paper in College

Write the number of atoms that comprise each compound on either side of the equation. Add a coefficient in front of elements that are not oxygen and hydrogen to balance each side.
